

Town of Jackson Selectmen's Meeting

Meeting convened at 6:30PM at the Town Office Meeting Room

The minutes from 01/17/17 were read. It is moved that the minutes be accepted as read and amended; motion seconded and the Select Board voted to accept the minutes as revised.

NEW BUSINESS:

Transfer Station:

Fire Department: received their communications grant for the pagers and radios.

Roads/Road Commissioner:

-Snowplow Bids 2017: the selectmen opened the bids for the snowplow contract; the bids came in as follows:

Anderson's Construction: \$3,299.00 per mile

Matt Brown: \$3,863.00 per mile

Farley & Son: \$5,200.00 per mile

Motion to accept Matt Brown's bid for the snowplow contract. Motion seconded and passed.

-Roadside Mowing: Selectmen discussed the particulars of this subject; The town/selectmen received a bid from Aggressive Cuts LLC for roadside mowing which was accepted for the flat shoulders of the road. Mr. Laliberte will call and get clarification for mowing time.

-Sand Shed is down to 25%. Selectmen discussed bringing in additional salt and sand.

Motion to engage FC Work to bring in 1200 yards of sand and two loads or 60 ton of salt. Motion seconded and passed.

Jackson Community Center (JCC):

Library/Historical Society: Fuel level at the library was discussed and future needs projected; Brenda will place an order to have the fuel tank refilled.

Veterans' Memorial: Flags are down until May. New ones have been ordered and paid for.
