Meeting convened at 6:55 PM at the Town Office Meeting Room

The minutes from 6/21/16 were read. **It is moved that the minutes be accepted as read and amended; motion seconded and the Select Board voted to accept the minutes as revised.**

NEW BUSINESS:

Transfer Station:

- Selectmen will consult U-line catalog for recycled bin options for cardboard.
- Brenda will make a sign advising that old paint can be disposed/recycled at Sherwin Williams.

Fire Department:

- Don Nickerson drove a fire truck in the Brooks Fourth of July parade.
- Brenda reported that the Fire Department received a \$2000 grant from MMA

Roads/Road Commissioner:

- FC Work is committed to sweeping the municipal parking lot before the Library chalk event.
- discussion on deteriorating culverts on Bog/Village Road.
- selectmen agreed roadside mowing should commence. Joe will contact the contractor.

Roads Improvement Project:

- Additional culverts have been installed as part of the project.
- Work is expected to resume in earnest, soon.

Jackson Community Center (JCC):

- Brenda gave some information regarding a recent state inspection. She will see that Jen Work gets a list of recommendations.
- the lawn has been mowed.
- Brenda will call Seacoast for their report.

Town Woodlot: Selectman will request a summary of the project from Wayne.

Library/Historical Society: The Select Board received an email from Louise Shorette about connecting with her or Don Nickerson Sr who will water clean the municipal parking lot for the Library chalk event.

Veterans' Memorial: Marlene was asked to be in the Brooks Fourth of July parade with the veterans.

Sexton/Cemeteries:

- discussion on the mowing contract. The sexton and the select board discussed the fact that the mowing scope is not being tended to in its entirety.

Town Clerk:

- discussion on setting up a special town meeting regarding the required town vote to determine which trash removal option Jackson will use.....whether to renew contract with PERC in 2018 or if we follow MRC and sign on to the Fiberrite.
- Brenda advised she will have the necessary information at the next meeting for selectmen to decide on the mill rate.
