NEW BUSINESS:

Louise Shorette attended the meeting to report on the Pucillio subdivision access and the Hadley Mill Pond access to the Hadley Mill Road Pond. She sought legal advice on the subject. The access path for the subdivision is not where it was thought to be. It was researched and defined. Public access for the Hadley Mill Pond has also been researched. Hadley Mill Pond is designated as a great pond and access cannot be denied because of a prescriptive-right-of-way.
